Carol Phillips	4	1	This photo (Phillips 1) was taken south of 502 Junction looking southeast from Bald Hill Road. The transmission line is shown as it crosses behind the residence. The closest structure is located at the top of the hill on the right of the photograph screened from view by the near tree. The inset image is provided to show the size and angle of the structure as it would appear behind this tree.
Carol Phillips	5	6	This photo (Phillips 6) was taken approximately 1,650 feet south of the residence in TrAILCo Rebuttal Exhibit TG-4 looking north across the small stream valley. The structure shown on the opposite side of the valley is on the top of the ridge.
Ridout	7	516, 517	The photos presented (Ridout 516 and 517) were taken near the Ridout driveway looking north along Rocky Ridge Road. Only existing condition photos are presented at this time for consideration. Structure locations for this section of the route are not available from the original design plans or preliminary engineering efforts. The route would be behind the trees and residence (not shown) on the hill to the far right in the photograph. Limited visibility is anticipated from this point.
Arnold	9	513, 514	Two photos are shown (Arnold 513 and 514) from the gravel drive east of the Arnold residence. Only existing condition photos are presented at this time for consideration. Structure locations for this section of the route are not available from the original design plans or preliminary engineering efforts. The line would be approximately 2,000 feet away from the observer point in the trees in the background.
Butcher	11	511, 512	Two photos are shown along Girards Fort Road looking southwest (Butcher 511) and west (Butcher 512) toward the proposed route. Only existing condition photos are presented at this time for consideration. Structure locations for this section of the route are not available from the original design plans or preliminary engineering efforts. The line would be approximately 2,000-2,500 feet from the observer point in the trees in the background.
Douglas	13	510	The photo presented (Douglas 510) was taken off of Girards Fort Road facing west approximately 2,200 feet from the structure location. This structure is near the end of the proposed modification from the original design. The structure placement is from the original design and may be modified. No structure location information is available to the left of the structure shown in this photo.

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Miller/Zalar	15, 16	519, 2	<p>Photo (Miller 519) was taken facing east approximately 1,800 feet from the structure shown in the left of the image. The line crosses the photo in a southwest/northeast orientation (right to left) across the image.</p> <p>Photo (Zalar 2) was taken facing south from a field on the Zalar property roughly 2,400 feet from the closest of the three structures traversing the far hill to the south. This photo required significant right of way simulation, and therefore should be considered an approximate rendering of structure placement and scale.</p>
Riccuiti/ Knetzer	18, 19	504, 1	<p>Photo (Riccuiti)504 was taken looking north out across the Riccuiti residence. Visibility is not anticipated from this vantage point.</p> <p>Photo (Knetzer 1) was taken from the back of the Knetzer residence. The original design plans call for a large ~2,300 foot span across the valley behind the house. No structures are located within this photo view; however, the lines will likely be visible crossing the valley.</p>
Mawhinney/ Donaldson	21, 22 22	9, 2, 4	<p>Photo (Mawhinney 9) was taken facing northeast approximately 3,000 feet from the nearest visible structure location from this vantage point on the Mawhinney property. The next structure to the north (left of center in the photo) is approximately 4,500 feet from this vantage point.</p> <p>Photos (Donaldson 2 and 4) were taken from the Donaldson residence, looking south (#2) and east (#4). Limited visibility of the line is anticipated from these two viewpoints due to vegetative screening. Visibility in the direction of photograph #4 may be more likely during the leaf-off (Fall and Winter) seasons.</p>
Foley	24, 25, 26	2, 10, 523	<p>Two photos are shown from the Foley property (Foley 2 and 10) and one photo is shown facing east northeast from a point west of the Foley property on Valley View Road. A structure is shown in the yard to the east of the Foley residence in Foley 2 (approximately 600 feet from viewpoint), and the lines from this tower from a photograph taken slightly closer to the Foley residence in Foley 10 (approximately 700 feet from the viewpoint). A landscape view is provided by photograph Foley 523 showing a broader perspective of the scene and the structure on the Foley property (approximately 1,200 feet from the viewpoint). The photosimulated version of this photograph was lightened to show detail.</p>

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Behm	28	4	The photo shown (Behm 4) was taken on the Behm property approximately 200 feet east of the Behm residence. Three structures were modeled in this photograph, the first on the far left (northern most) of the photo is approximately 750 feet from the viewpoint, the second is slightly more than 1,600 feet from the viewpoint, and the last (southernmost) is approximately 2,100 feet from the viewpoint.
Nicoloff/ Teagarden	30, 31, 32	50, 51, 503	Two photos are shown from the Nicoloff property (Nicoloff 50 and 51) showing two structures that are proposed approximately 1,500 feet southwest from the photograph location. The line crosses the Nicoloff property along its southwestern edge. One photo is shown facing east from Jefferson Marianna Road near the Teagarden property (Teagarden 503). The structure shown in the photo would be approximately 1,500 feet from this viewpoint.
Eggleston, Charles Snyder, Pam and Jack Snyder	34, 35, 36	Charles Snyder 2, Pam and Jack Snyder 2, Vanderslice 4	Three photo locations are presented for this area. The first, from the Charles Snyder property (Charles Snyder 2) shows a structure approximately 1,750 feet from the viewpoint behind the barn in the distance. The second photograph was taken of the structure that would be between 500-600 feet from this viewpoint in the Pam and Jack Snyder back yard (Pam and Jack Snyder 2). The third set of photographs (Vanderslice 4) shows a landscape perspective of the scene, with the same structure shown in the previous two photosimulations shown in the far left (approximately 1,750 feet from the viewpoint), and a second (approximately 2,500 feet from the viewpoint) down the hillslope on the far right of the image.
Piroch	38, 39	Piroch 1 and 549	Two photo locations are shown for the Piroch residence. The first (Piroch1) was taken from the Piroch driveway looking north. The route crosses this viewpoint heading due north. The structure on the left of the image is approximately 750 feet from the observer point. This photo required significant right of way simulation, and therefore should be considered an approximate rendering of structure placement and scale. The second set of photographs shown is from a point north of the Piroch residence (Piroch 549) looking south approximately 1,600 feet from the structure behind the residence.

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Luciano/ Roule	41, 42	4, 551	Two photograph sets are provided. The first is from the Luciano property, facing west toward the line (Luciano 4). The structure in the photograph is behind the barn to the right, approximately 650' from the observer point. The second set of photographs was taken along Oak Spring Road north of the Roule property facing south (Roule 551). The line traverses the eastern front of the Roule property toward and to the left of the observation point. The structure shown would be 800' from the observer point.
Blank (south)	44	553	The photo shown (Blank 553) was taken along Daniels Run Road looking northeast approximately 900 feet from the tower shown. The structure would be in the background through trees on the center left of the image. The lines are shown as they pass through the background.
Blank (north)	46	4	This photo was taken on the Blank property, facing northeast (Blank 4). Two structures on the far hill are shown, the closest, (center right) is approximately 2,300 feet from the observation point, the second (center left) is approximately 2,900 feet from the observation point.
Brogley, Cross, and Lemley	48	560	The photo presented (Brogley 560) was taken just east of the Brogley residence facing south along the right of way showing the Lemley (right) and Cross (left) properties on the ridge. This photo required right of way simulation, and therefore should be considered an approximate rendering of structure placement and scale. Additional structures along the ridge may be more visible from this view.
McCune	50	12	The photo presented (McCune 12) is taken just off of Chesterfield Lane facing west toward one of two of the structures proposed on the McCune property. The structure would be approximately 800 feet from the viewpoint.
Burkhardt	52	565	The photo presented (Burkhardt 565) was taken east of the Burkhardt property, approximately 800 feet from the structure shown in the center of the simulation. It should be noted that the right of way shown is slightly offset on the newest aerial photography. The house is adjacent to the edge of the right of way.
Pollock	54, 55	572, 574	Two sets of photographs are shown. The first (Pollock 572) was taken west of the line approximately 2,000 feet from the simulated structure shown in the far left of the image. The second photo (Pollock 574) was taken east of the line along Ankrom Road. The structure in the simulated photo would be approximately 1,650 feet southwest of the viewpoint.

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Cameron	57, 58	4, 576	Two photographs are presented. The first (Cameron 4) was taken from the center of the Cameron property looking northeast toward the 500 kV structure 1,000 feet from the viewpoint and the 138 kV structure on the right of the image ~750 feet from the viewpoint. The second photograph (Cameron 576) was taken from Lively Road, which runs along the east side of the Cameron property. This photograph is directed toward the same structures presented in #4, but from a different vantage point. The structures shown are 1,650 feet and 1,250 feet from the viewpoint (500 kV and 138 kV respectively).
Hollier, Thomas, and Kirshner	60, 61	2, 585	Two sets of photographs are presented. The first (Hollier 2) was taken from the Hollier backyard facing northeast along the route towards the residences on Young Road. The first 500 kV structure shown is on the hill above the Thomas residence, approximately 1,250 feet from the observer point. A 138 kV structure is located slightly further north approximately 1,500 feet from the observer point. Additional 500 kV structures shown in the distance are approximately 2,500 and 3,000 feet from the observer point. The second set of photographs (Kirschner/Thomas 585) is presented from the perspective of Young Road facing east, showing the structure (behind the tree) on the hill above the Thomas residence, and the 138 kV pole just beyond the curve in Young Road. These structures are approximately 1,200 feet and 1,100 feet from the observer, respectively.
Blockinger	63	587	This photograph (Blockinger 587) was taken on West Patterson Road looking northeast toward the structures located north of the Blockinger property. The structure shown in the center of the photograph is approximately 1,750 feet from the observer point.

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Simmons/ Sullivan	65, 66, 67, 68	2, 591, 4, 592, 594, 595	<p>Five different photographs are presented for this set, two of which have photosimulations. Photograph (Simmons 2) from the Simmons property, faces due east toward the 138 kV line. Only the lines are photosimulated in this view. It should be noted that some trees in the right of way visible in this photo may be removed. However, this tree removal was not simulated because trees would continue to exist behind the trees removed, and it is believe that the remaining trees would be on the same visual plane. Photographs were also taken from a point southwest of the Simmons property facing northeast along Thomas 84 Road (Simmons 591). The wires of the 138 kV line are shown as they cross Thomas 84 Road.</p> <p>Photo Sullivan 4 is taken from the Sullivan property facing west toward the 500 kV and 138 kV lines. Photos Sullivan 592, 594, and 595 are from a location on Thomas 84 Road, just south of the Sullivan residence facing north, northwest, and west, respectively. Due to intervening vegetation and topography, limited visibility is anticipated from these sites. However, additional detailed topographic information and current structure location and design plans would be needed to verify this.</p>
Dire	70	599	<p>One photo is shown (Dire 599) facing west from McBride Road to the 138 kV structure approximately 750 feet to the west. The Dire property is behind the trees on the far left of the photograph.</p>
